

Born in Seville (Spain) in 1977. **David Gómez Ramírez** is one of the most promising young conductors and composers in Spain. He has been director of the Lira Saguntina Symphony Orchestra in Valencia, as well as director of the Conservatory of Music “Joaquin Rodrigo” in Sagunto, Valencia since 2007. He has been the resident conductor in Seville and Coutances (France) Orchestre.

During the past seven years, he has conducted all the major Spanish orchestras and he appears as a guest conductor in Europe (Italy, France, Portugal, The Netherlands), in Asia and in South America, in such musical centers as Paris, Havana (Cuba), Brussels (Belgium), Hanoi, Hue and Ho Chi Minh City (Vietnam), Moscow, Saint Petersburg and Nizhni Novgorod (Russia), etc. He made his directing debut with the Russian Symphony Orchestra Young Virtuoso of Moscow State Conservatory Tchaikovsky.

He studied Piano, Trumpet, Musicology, Composition and Orchestra & Chorus Conducting at Superior Music Conservatory in Seville and Valencia. He studied conducting with maestro Enrique Garcia Asensio, Pedro Morales, George Pehlivanian etc. As a composer, he has written a wide range of musical compositions from chamber music to large orchestral forms. He has won several first prizes in National Composition Competitions in Alicante, Cordoba and Murcia. In 2001, he received the "First Music Award" granted by the Excellency Cultural Arts and Sciences Association. In 2010 received the “Giraldillo de Oro” prize, the highest award given by the Excellency in Cultural Arts and Sciences Association “Popular Ateneo de Sevilla” (an Institution recognized by UNESCO and the Ministry of Culture of Spain).

He has made numerous recordings for various record companies (Pasarela, Melody Records, Alzur Producciones, among others), Spanish national radio, and television as well.
